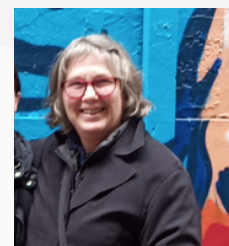

Hello everyone,

Last weekend was exceptionally busy in Esk as the Esk Garden Fair drew record crowds. The SASI stall drew great interest and many artworks were sold. Congratulations to those who sold and thank you to all who assisted on the day, especially our Stalls convener, Sue Howard. The next opportunity to sell your artwork is coming up on 3,4 July at the Watts Bridge Air Show.

Organising these stalls and opportunities to sell your artwork is just one of the many activities that SASI organises for its members. We also coordinate and curate the exhibitions in Glen Rock Gallery at the Esk Visitor Information Centre. Many artists have felt the excitement of exhibiting for the first time there. Workshops are organised in various media throughout the year and provided at a very reasonable cost. Biennially, we organise the Somerset Bendigo Bank Art Awards, the major arts event of the region.

Two groups of like-minded people meet in friendship weekly to paint or craft, one in Fernvale and one at Mt Beppo. The SASI Photography group meets for workshops and for photographic excursions. All of our activities are reported in a very informative newsletter and on an up to date website, where membership and workshop participation can be registered.

We have general meetings four times a year. The last was held at my place in May and we enjoyed a convivial post-meeting pizza party. It was lovely to socialise together. The next meeting is the Annual General Meeting on Saturday, 21 August at 2pm in St Agnes Hall, Esk. It is very important to come along as due to various personal reasons all of the core committee positions will be vacated. I have thoroughly enjoyed my seven years on the committee and loved making things happen for my community.

**SASI can't continue to offer these benefits without a committee.** Please consider if you have some skills to offer. Check out the **positions vacant** on page 10 and **position descriptions** on page 11. A computer accompanies each executive position (president, secretary, treasurer). Past committee members will help explain our activities but, as a committee, you can choose to offer whatever activities you wish.

All of the main activities can tick over as usual with the organisers still in place; Glen Rock Gallery, Mt Beppo and Fernvale Artists, the Photography group and workshops. The Art Awards does not have to go ahead if it is not possible. A newsletter editor and a web master will need to be found. As an incorporated group, we insure our activities and members. SASI is also registered with Centrelink for volunteers (on committee) between 55 and 66 to meet Centrelink requirements. (Page 9)

Please come to the AGM to nominate and vote on possible committee positions or, if no one steps forward, on the closure of the society. You will need to be a member to nominate or be nominated and to vote. Membership is open now for 21/22. If SASI folds, your membership will be reimbursed.

### Photography Tips for Portraits

A couple of things you can do to make your portrait photos stand out:

1. To create a blurry background and give separation between your subject and the background you can use a wide lens aperture or if you're in the backyard or near a wall, make sure there is some distance between the subject and background.
2. Have the sun behind your subject! You may need to give more exposure when taking the photo to expose the face correctly, but this technique should create beautiful rim lighting around the head and when done correctly, it results in beautiful images. It does take practice though!

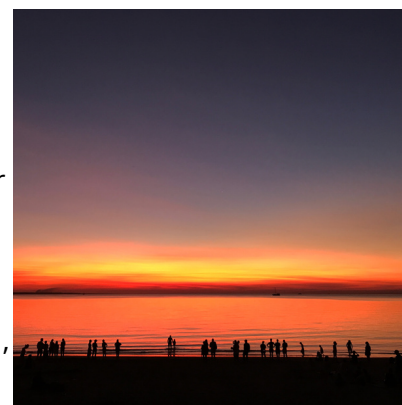

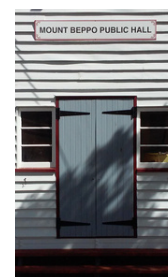

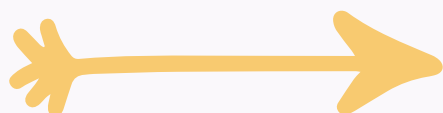
